Michael Marsiske is Professor in the Department of Clinical and Health Psychology in the College of Public Health and Health Professions.

He is the Director of the Cognitive Aging Lab, which is based in the Department of Clinical and Health Psychology, in the College of Public Health and Health Professions, at the University of Florida.

Dr. Marsiske received his Ph.D. from the Pennsylvania State University in 1992 (Human Development and Family Studies). He followed this with a postdoctoral fellowship in Psychology and Human Development at the Max Planck Institute for Human Development and Education in Berlin (1992-1995). Prior to joining the University of Florida in 2000, Dr. Marsiske was an Assistant Professor of Gerontology and Psychology at Wayne State University.
